

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

1. CONTEST

1.1 The University of British Columbia (“**UBC**”) is a contest sponsor of the UBC Malcolm Knapp Research Forest Scavenger Hunt.

1.2 This contest will start June 7, 2025 and end on completing the Scavenger Hunt before 11:59 PM on June 30, 2025.

2. HOW TO ENTER

2.1 No purchase necessary. Only one entry per person per scavenger hunt location. This contest is open to entrants residing in Canada during the contest and who are the age of majority in their province of residence, excluding Quebec residents and employees and faculty members of UBC who are administering the UBC Forestry Scavenger Hunt (the “**Entrant(s)**”)

2.2 Entrants may enter this contest by completing the Scavenger Hunt before 11:59 PM on June 30, 2025.

3. HOW TO WIN

3.1 Winners will be randomly selected Wednesday, July 2, 2025, and will be announced on Thursday, July 3, 2025 at approximately 3:30 PM. The odds of winning depend on the number of Entries.

4. PRIZES

4.1 The prizes will be as follows:

(i) 5th place:

(ii) 4th place:

Sweatshirt with Malcolm Knapp Research Forest branding (approximate value: \$60)

(iii) 3rd Place:

(iv) 2nd Place

1 week of Wild & Immersive Summer Day Camp programming for 1 child in 2026

(v) 1st Place

4.2 The prizes must be accepted as awarded. No substitutions of the prizes are permitted except by UBC at its discretion. UBC reserves the right to substitute any prize with another prize of equal or greater value if a prize cannot be awarded as described for any reason. The prizes are non-transferable and are not redeemable for cash or credit, in whole or in part. The winner(s) cannot win more than one prize.

4.3 UBC will require the winner(s) to: (a) correctly answer a skill-testing question, and (b) to sign a declaration and release, which may include consent to UBC posting the winner's name and photograph on its website, email communications, and social media. If a winner fails to return such contest documents within the time specified by UBC, they will forfeit their prize and an alternate winner will be selected.

5.4 UBC reserves the right to cancel, terminate, or suspend this contest, at its discretion, at any time without prior notice.

Entries made with multiple addresses, under multiple identities, or through the use of any device or other method to enter multiple times or entries that are in excess of the permitted number of entries are automatically void.
